2 ~~— (a) Contents of SYP If a SYP is submitted, it~~ A SYP may be submitted at the discretion of the
3 timber and timberland owner and shall be prepared under the supervision of and signed by an RPF and

4 **The SYP** shall include contain the following information:

5 ~~— (1) Name and Address of timber and timberland owner.~~

6 ~~— (2) Ownership description and location, including legal descriptions and maps depicting the~~
7 ~~ownership and Management Units which shall be at a scale sufficient to allow the Director to~~
8 ~~determine the area covered by the SYP.~~

9 ~~— (3) Management objectives for resources addressed in the SYP, including timber products.~~

10 ~~— (4) General narrative description of the forest types, fish and wildlife habitats and watercourses~~
11 ~~and lakes.~~

12 ~~— (5) Descriptions of Management Units (e.g., planning watersheds or larger areas) and rationale~~
13 ~~for Management Unit selection.~~

14 ~~— (6) Identification and mapping of Planning watersheds classified as sensitive watersheds and~~
15 ~~description of the measures taken to protect resources within those watersheds.~~

16 ~~— (7) A checklist list, also for inclusion to be included with individual THP submissions, that~~
17 identifies, for the benefit of agency and public review, specific mitigation measures or requirements
18 described in the SYP, in addition to the standard Forest Practice Rules, that are to be implemented in
19 THPs tiered to the SYP. Such measures or requirements may include, but are not limited to specific
20 resource protection measures; fish, wildlife, or botanical surveys; **standardized management**
21 **practices;** standardized , road and tractor trail crossing specifications; and standardized, **and** erosion
22 control procedures., among others.

1 **1091.9 SYP Effective Period**

2 The effective period of a SYP shall be no more than ~~ten~~ years. ~~An SYP Renewal of a currently~~
3 ~~approved SYP may be granted for an additional ten-year period following agency and public review and~~
4 ~~upon approval of the Director pursuant to §1091.15.~~

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6 **1091.15 Renewal of Sustained Yield Plans Renewal**

7 A currently approved SYP may be renewed for an additional ~~ten (10)~~ **ten**-year period subject to the
8 ~~review and approval of the Director. A proposed SYP Renewal shall be submitted to the Director~~
9 **no more than one-year and no less than six-months prior to expiration of a currently approved**
10 **SYP.** The Director's determination shall be based upon multi-disciplinary review and evaluation of the
11 ~~elements of the SYP Renewal submission to determine if the SYP Renewal satisfies the requirements~~
12 ~~of MSP, identifies potentially significant adverse impacts, and includes feasible mitigation measures~~
13 ~~for avoidance of such impacts. The SYP Renewal submitter is encouraged to consult with review team~~
14 ~~agencies prior to submission of a proposed SYP Renewal.~~

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16 **(a) Contents of SYP Renewal**

17 A SYP Renewal submission shall **be limited to proposed revisions of the original submission and**
18 **any significant new information related to watershed condition and environmental setting,**
19 **timber growth and yield, management practices, mitigation measures, and resource protection**
20 **standards. The proposed revisions and any new information shall be considered an amendment**
21 **to the original approved SYP pursuant to §1091.13.**

22
23 **The SYP Renewal submitter shall specifically identify, in an introductory table or index format,**
24 **proposed revisions to the original approved SYP, and any new information. The introductory**
25 **table or index shall also identify by page number the specific location in the SYP Renewal where**
further information on the proposed revisions or new subject matter may be found. ~~contain all of~~

1 ~~the information required in the original submission pursuant to §1091.4, 1091.4.5, 1091.5, and 1091.6.~~

2 ~~In addition, the SYP Renewal shall identify any changes to watershed condition and environmental~~
3 ~~setting, timber growth and yield information, management practices, mitigation measures, and resource~~
4 ~~protection standards that have occurred since approval of the previous SYP submission.~~

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6 (b) Within 20-days of the receipt of a SYP **R**enewal submission, the Director shall determine if the
7 SYP **R**enewal is complete, accurate, and in proper order. If so, the SYP **R**enewal shall be filed. If the
8 SYP **R**enewal is not acceptable for filing, the Director shall return the SYP **R**enewal with a written
9 explanation of the deficiencies. Where the Director does not make this determination within 20-days,
10 the SYP **R**enewal shall be deemed filed.

11
12 (c) Once the SYP **R**enewal has been accepted for filing, the Director shall have 60-days or longer as
13 mutually agreed to by the submitter to conduct the agency and public review of the SYP **R**enewal
14 submission.

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16 (d) Public Notice of SYP Renewal. The Director shall transmit notice to the public and agencies
17 consistent with the noticing requirements of §1037.5 and §1037.1(b)(1-5). The Notice shall advise the
18 public of the name of the submitter, geographic location of the SYP **R**enewal, location(s) where a
19 copy of the SYP **R**enewal can be reviewed or obtained, and when and where the public hearing will be
20 held. ~~The SYP renewal submitter is encouraged to provide publicly available copies of the renewal~~
21 ~~submission in a digital format.~~

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23 (e) Public Hearing. The Director shall hold a public hearing on the SYP **R**enewal within 30-days from
24 the start of the public review period. The SYP **R**enewal submitter shall participate with the Director in
25 that hearing.

1 (f) Director's Determination Period. At the end of the public review and comment period, the Director
2 shall have 10-days to review public input, consider recommendations and mitigation measures of other
3 public agencies, respond in writing to the issues raised, and determine if the SYP **Renewal** is in
4 conformance with the rules. If the SYP **Renewal** is found to be in conformance, it shall be approved by
5 the Director.

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7 (g) SYP Renewal Disapproval. If the Director disapproves **an** SYP **Renewal**, the Director shall provide
8 written reasons for disapproval that conform with §1054. Appeal of the Director's decision on an SYP
9 **Renewal** submission shall be conducted pursuant to §1091.11.

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
