8 **§ 1104.1 Conversion Exemptions**

10 ****(H) No Sites of rare, threatened or endangered plants or animals shall be disturbed,
11 threatened or damaged and no timber operations shall occur within the buffer zone of a
12 sensitive species as defined in 14 CCR 895.1

13 (I) No timber operations on significant historical or archeological sites, except under
14 the following conditions:

15 1. If a significant archeological site is identified by the RPF preparing the Notice
16 of Conversion Exemption within the project boundary, the site may be
17 preserved in place by capping or covering with a layer of soil prior to
18 submission.

19 a. If a site has been preserved in place, the RPF preparing the Notice of
20 Conversion Exemption shall obtain written concurrence from a
21 Department Archeologist prior to submission indicating operations will
22 not cause damage to a significant archeological site.

23 b. The written concurrence from a Department Archeologist shall be
24 submitted with the Notice of Conversion Exemption.

25 (J) The RPF and the timber operator shall meet (on-site, or off-site) if *****
