There is one current vacancy on the Professional Foresters Examining Committee (PFEC). This vacancy is for an RPF consultant member, and the incumbent member has expressed their desire for re-appointment.

Mr. Christian Eggleton, RPF 3073, wishes to continue in his role on the committee for which he has served since 2019. Mr. Eggleton was awarded his bachelor's degree in Environmental Economics and Policy and his master's degree in City and Regional Planning from the University of California Berkeley in 2008 and 2010 respectively. He passed his RPF exam in January 2018 and immediately co-founded Forest Resources Solutions and Technologies (FRST).
