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"SPOTTED OWL RESOURCE PLAN AMENDMENT, 2022"

Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (14 CCR):

Division 1.5, Chapter 4, Subchapter 1

§ 895.1. Definitions.

Spotted Owl Resource Plan means a plan that demonstrates an approach to

preventing a taking of the northern spotted owl while conducting \underline{T} timber $\underline{harvest}$

Oeperations. A Spotted Owl Resource Plan necessarily involves Timber Operations

conducted under Notices of Timber Operations for an NTMP, Working Forest Harvest

Notices under a WFMP, and/or more than one timber harvest plan area THP.
