## CA Rangeland Education (CRED)

Funded at \$30,000 as a planning activity under Higher Education Challenge grant (USDA-NIFA)

Project Directors – Susan Edinger Marshall, Marc Horney, Pelayo Alvarez, Lynn Huntsinger Objectives:

- a. Identify strengths and weaknesses in existing curricula.
- b. Create a comprehensive CRM study guide to be posted as a curated collection on "RangeDocs" (<a href="https://docs.rangelandsgateway.org/">https://docs.rangelandsgateway.org/</a>).
- c. Suggest integrative new courses for contemporary challenges in ecosystem stewardship.
- d. Develop a "learning outcomes diagnostic panel" and "prescription" to assess participant skills and to accomplish participant goals.
- e. Frame a pilot place-based learning cohort in partnership with a working ranch. The objective here will be to position learning outcomes in a meaningful, integrated context, in service to the goals of the collaborating landowner.

### CRED

Collected more than 100 responses at CCA/NCA meeting in Sparks NOV/Dec 2023

- Only about 90% had heard of CRM program
- Most participating students enrolled in Animal Science
- Many ranchers would be interested in learning more and/or participating in educational efforts
- Participants will also be polled at CRCC (visit our booth!)
